Magic Tricks for Grand Parents

- Provides an enjoyable, interactive program to brighten spirits of seniors during the winter months
- Helps seniors improve dexterity and circulation by learning magic and sleight of hand tricks

The cost for each individual program is:

- \$250 One 45-60 minute show at nursing home or assisted living facility
- \$100 Each additional follow-up workshop

Jim Snack witnessed his first magic trick at age 6 when his grandfather made four aces magically appear from a deck of cards. It happened on the living room rug at his grand parents' house and Jim never forgot the experience. Many years later he learned to perform magic and has been entertaining with his illusions for over 30 years.

Jim has performed at schools, colleges, community centers, fairs and festivals in the Capital District since 1979. Capital District audiences may remember him as co-host with Chris Jansing of WNYT-TV 13's award winning "For Kid's Sake Follies" television program. For over a decade, Jim was a feature performer for Albany's First Night Celebration.

When he is not entertaining audiences with magic, Jim is a much sought after national keynote speaker and trainer. With degrees in theater and communications, Jim specializes in combining the two in his programs. He serves as an adjunct faculty member at the Eastern Management Development Center in Shepherdstown, WVA, where he teaches collaborative leadership, and the General Services Administration PBS Academy where he teaches creativity and innovation.

Jim is a one less than 600 speakers worldwide who holds the *Certified Speaking Professional* (CSP) designation, the highest earned award bestowed by the National Speakers Association. He is past president of the Hudson-Mohawk Chapter of the American Society of Training and Development and past president of the Connecticut Chapter of the National Speakers Association

Whether Jim is presenting a motivational keynote on "The Magic of Change" for a national association, representing a company at a corporate trade show, or stressing the importance of reading to school children, his presentations are always a captivating blend of magic and message.

In addition, Jim gives back to the community by providing free shows to deserving non-profit organizations through his <u>Sharing Magic</u> project. Jim's newest program, Magic Tricks for Grand Parents, is designed to cultivate and share a sense of wonder with Capital District senior citizens.
